If we are to fulfill this mission, each of us must commit ourselves to a covenant of mutual care, love and respect. This Youth Group Behavioral Covenant sets forth our commitment.

Members agree and covenant not to misappropriate, steal or damage any property belonging to a fellow youth group Member, a youth staff/volunteer member, or any organization or facility that partners with or welcomes the youth group to their facility or program.

Members agree and covenant not to engage in sexual activity or inappropriate sexual behavior during the trip or during any related event or activity.

I understand that the Youth Group maintains a Zero Tolerance standard for violations of the Behavioral Covenant. Should my child violate any of the rules listed under the **Youth Group Behavioral Covenant**, I expect to be asked to immediately travel to the location of the mission trip to withdraw my child from the group and to accompany my child home. If requested, I will willingly comply with such request.
